The field includes Asian Junior and World Junior medalists, as well as senior players who have represented India at Asian and World-level competitions. This gives the tournament a rare combination of development pathway value and elite competitive experience.

With PSA ranking points available in the senior events and Asian Junior Ranking points across junior categories, Southern Slam provides meaningful competitive incentives at multiple stages of the player pathway.
